Hanukkah is a Jewish holiday. About 200 years before Jesus was born, Israel was controlled by the Seleucid Empire. King Antiochus IV Epiphanes banned Judaism, said they couldn't go to the temple or worship God. 5 brothers (Macabees) led a rebellion. They defeated Antiochus' army and pushed them out of Jerusalem. They then spent 8 days cleaning the temple and rededicating it to God. The miracle of Hanukkah is that even though they only had enough oil to light their lamp for 1 day, it lasted 8 days while they cleaned the temple. Every year, Jews remember the 8 day rededication of the temple by celebrating the 8 days of Hanukkah. The Bible tells us that even Jesus celebrated Hanukkah (John 10:22)!
