## Family/Activity

**Put A Stamp On It** = Cut a large raw potato in half length-wise. Then write "God" in simple block letters on the center cut section of the potato, or you could cut the letters, "G-O-D" out of paper and pin them to the potato. Use a sharp knife to slice into the potato about 1/4 inch to 1/2 inch deep along the edges of the letters. Then cut away the chunks of potato so that the letters stand out to make a potato stamp that says "GOD." While you are doing the cutting, have your children draw pictures or write out things that cause them to be afraid. Some suggestions might be: getting hit by a baseball pitch, a big test at school, mean kids, car accidents, etc. As they draw and you cut the potato, remind them of the Bible story about Joshua. Joshua was able to have courage because God was with him. When the drawings are done and the potato stamp is ready, get some craft paint and let the children "put a stamp on it." Use the "GOD" stamp on the children's drawings of the things they are afraid of. Tell the children that this is to remind them that no matter what happens, God is with them. Because God is with them, they can have courage in tough situations just like Joshua.


