Family/Activity

Follow Me While your children are asleep, or before they come home from school, take a large skein of yarn or roll of string and walk a path all over and around your house leaving the string behind. Make sure that the path goes through some obstacles: a door that you close and lock, a large piece of furniture that you move in the way, etc. Mark the start with a piece of paper. When your children get home or wake up, tell them that you walked around and you want them to follow the path you walked. Tell them that you made a way for them to follow you by leaving a trail. Then have them follow the trail until they get to an obstacle. When they come to an obstacle, help them get through it. Unlock the door (or make the key easy to find), move the furniture for them, carry them over it, etc. When they have finished the trail, remind them of the Main Point: God Will Make A Way For Me To Follow Him! Tell them that God gave us the Bible so that we would know how to follow Him, and that when we run into obstacles that God will make a way for us to follow Him.


