Boston and Beans are covered in pie. Help them find their way through the maze of pie traps to get to the barracks so they can clean up.



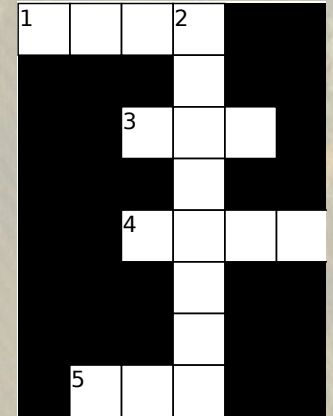
