do not follow through on your promise. Some of the promises you could make might be promising to make a favorite breakfast and then providing cereal, promising to go to the park but staying home instead, or promising to make a special dessert. Toward the end of the day, ask your family how it made them feel when you did not keep your promises. Then talk about how God always keeps His promises for our lives. After talking with your family about God's promises, you may want to keep one of the promises you made by going to the park or baking a dessert as a family.
