Families That Pray Together, Stay Together- Make family prayer time a priority each week. Get together as a family and write down prayers that each family member has. Write the prayer out in a family prayer journal. You can also post these prayers on a poster board or large sheet of paper in a visible spot in the home like the kitchen. While writing down requests, talk with the children about the importance of praying and tell stories of different prayers that God has answered in your life. Praying together each week will help reinforce how prayer should be a priority in our relationship with God and create a habit that will carry on into adulthood.

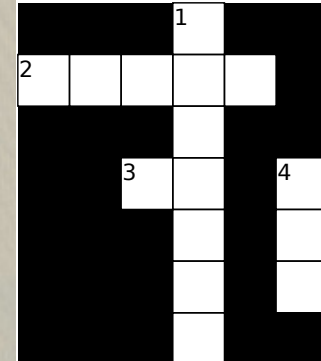

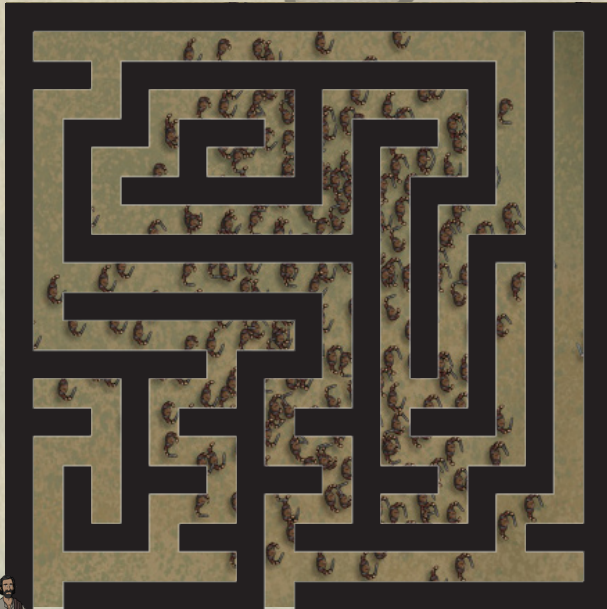
