Today the children learned about justification, grace and faith, and discovered how they can put the Good News into action.

A FEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR THE WAY HOME:

- What does the word justified mean? (*To declare that someone or something is just, right, or reasonable.*)
- What does grace mean? (*Grace is unmerited favor - being given something BETTER than what you deserve.*)
- Paul's Epistles help us everyday as we put the Good News into action. How can you put the Good News into action this week?
- To have faith in God is to believe He is who He says He is and that He'll do what He says He'll do. Can you think of a time when your faith in God helped you do something hard or a little bit scary?
- Today you praised God by shouting "We praise you Jesus for justification, grace, and righteousness!" Let's remember to say that together this week.
