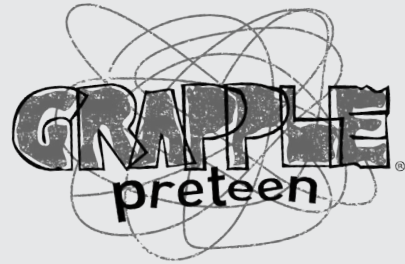

## Dig Into the Bible:

Genesis 1:1-2; Psalms 90:1-2; 102:24-28; Isaiah 48:12-13; John 1:1-4; Revelation 22:13

Have you ever heard of an eternal flame? With your child, type *eternal flame* into an Internet search engine, and see what pops up. Eternal flames are most often used to honor deceased people who've made significant contributions to society.

Unlike human lives that have a beginning and an end on this earth, God always has been and always will be around. Create an "eternal flame" in your home by buying or finding a special candle to remind you of God's everlasting presence. Place the candle where you'll see it often—on the dinner table or over the fireplace, for example. During special events, such as family dinners, holidays, or other celebrations, burn the candle to remind your family of God's presence.
