- Genesis 12:3; Numbers 14:21; Isaiah 11:9
- Habakkuk 2:14 For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea.
- Question: Whose job was it to get the light and blessings of God out to all nations?
- Answer: Israel (Isaiah 49:6)

- 1. What from Sunday's message regarding Paul's missionary journeys inspired you in your own journey to live for Christ in a hostile world?

- 3. Read Matthew 28:18-20, Mark 16:15, Luke 24:46-48 and John 20:21. According to these verses, what "work" did Jesus give us to do? How are you glorifying God in this "work" within your family, church, workplace, or community?
- 4. In order to do God's work of disciple making, God has given every believer the indwelling Holy Spirit. The Spirit was promised by Jesus in John 14:15-17 and again in Acts 1:8. What do these passages teach about the Holy Spirit and the help He can give? How have you sensed the Spirit working in your life and ministry?
- 5. In **Matthew 16:24** Jesus said, "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me." What does it mean to "deny oneself" in following Christ? Give some examples.

6. Read **2 Timothy 3:12**. What opposition or resistance have you experienced while seeking to serve others or share your faith? How does this verse help Christians gain the "right mindset" in difficult circumstances?
