- Patriarchs (Abraham, Isaac, Jacob & Joseph): God births & builds a new nation on faith
 - Ingredients of a Great Nation
 - A. People B. Order C. Land
- ► Sojourn in Egypt: God causes Israel to grow
- ► Exodus: God liberates Israel from bondage
- ► Sojourn in the Desert: God's New Order + Israel's Rebellion
- ▶ Time of Joshua: Entering, Conquering & Possessing the Promise Land
 - A generation characterized by <u>radical</u> <u>bedience</u>
- God honor those who honor Him
- Godly living involves warfare.
- God has no <u>grandchildren</u>

FROM THE JUDGES TO THE MAKING OF A GREAT NATION

- Period of the Judges: Apostasy, Oppression, Anguish, Judge, Liberation, Peace
- Spiritual <u>compromise</u> leads to a <u>cursed</u> life.
- 95% <u>obedience</u> = total <u>disobedience</u>.
- Samuel & Israel's Transition to a "Theocratic" Monarchy
 - Saul David Solomon
- Uniqueness of the Book of Psalms
 - Israel's hymnal
 - <u>Five</u> books
- Written by <u>various</u> <u>authors</u>

- Messianic prophecy
- <u>Widely</u> <u>guoted</u> in the New Testament
- Characterized by <u>emotional</u>

- 1. Thinking back to Sunday's message, what really impacted, challenged, or encouraged you this week?
- 2. Briefly list and define or describe each of the six stages in the "cycle of Judges." Next **read Judges 3:7-11** and tell where each stage is found in the narrative.
- 3. Have you ever experienced any of the stages of the "cycle of judges" in your own life or seen them in the life of someone you know? (Please don't use names.)
- 4. **Read Genesis 12:1-3**. In these verses God told Abraham how He would bless him and his descendants. In the passages below, how was God fulfilling some of these promises?
 - 1 Kings 10:1-13

1 Kings 10:14-29

5. **Read 1 Kings 9:1-9**. Notice that verses 6-7 are an "If/Then" statement. Does that mean that God's love is conditional or just His blessing? What might be God's reason for making such a statement?

DIGGING EVEN DEEPER

- 6. **Read 1 Kings 11:1-13**. What was one of the major influences in Solomon's life that turned him away from God? How could he have avoided this? How does **Genesis 2:24** apply?
- 7. What are some of the things today that tend to draw people away from a close relationship with God? What can believers do to change this?
- 8. In your estimation, is it easier to drift away from God or to stay close to Him? How do the following influences apply?
