The Protection of the Believer

HELP! WE SEEM A LITTLE OVER EXPOSED HERE! (Matthew 10:16)

- Positionally Christ-followers are already seated with Jesus in the Heavenly Realms
- Physically, however, we still live and minister in hostile territory where we are vulnerable
- James 4:7; 1 Peter 5:8-9

► The battle is... <u>opiritual</u> <u>personal</u> <u>daily</u>

Question: What is our defense or protection in this warfare?

GDD IS OUR PROTECTION

- Psalm 18:2 Our rock, fortress, deliverer, refuge, shield, horn of salvation, stronghold
- Psalm 32:7 Our hiding place, protection from trouble, deliverer
 - Biblical Balance: God protects us as we engage in spiritual warfare. (Passivity is not an option)

EPHESUS / EPHESIANS 6:10-20

• BE <u>STRONG</u> (v. 10)

In the Lord

► In His mighty power

PRINCIPLE #1: The only way to experience <u>victory</u> (or even survive) in this spiritual battle is through the <u>protection</u> & <u>strength</u> of Christ.

<u>
PUT_ON</u> (v. 11)

- ► The full armor of God
- ► So that you can stand against the devil's schemes

PRINCPLE #2: The Armor of God represents all that we <u>are</u> in Christ & all that we <u>have</u> in Christ. (Putting on the Armor of God = <u>Putting</u> on <u>Christ</u>)

- John 14:30; Romans 13:12-14
- PRINCIPLE #3: The armor is for <u>believer</u> living in <u>community</u>, not for <u>individuals</u> doing it on their own.
- © <u>STAND</u> <u>FIRM</u> (vv. 13,14)

- <u>Bet</u> of <u>Truth</u> (v.14; cf. John 8:31-32; 44; 14:6)
- ► <u>Breastplate</u> of <u>Righteousness</u> (v.14; cf.1 Corinthians 1:30; 2 Corinthians 5:1; Romans 8:33-34)
- ► Footwear of Gospel <u>Readiness</u> (v.15; cf. Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8; Colossians 4:6; Philemon 6)
- ▶ <u>Shield</u> of <u>Faith</u> (v.16; Romans 10:17)
- ► <u>Helmet</u> of <u>Salvation</u> (v.17; cf. 1 Thessalonians 5:8))
- <u>Sword</u> of the <u>Spirit</u> (v.17; 2 Timothy 3:16-17)

- 5. Read **Acts 19:1-20**. What were some of the things that happened in Ephesus that made it the perfect location for Paul to send his teaching on spiritual armor?
- 6. What is the first piece of spiritual armor mention in **Ephesians 6:13-18**? Do you think there is a reason it was listed first? Explain.

- 7. List all of the pieces of spiritual armor found in **Ephesians 6:13-18**. What is significant about each one, and why is each essential to having victory in spiritual warfare?
- 8. Read **Romans 13:12-14**. How do these verses support the idea that putting on the Armor of God is equivalent to putting on Christ? What does it mean to you "to put on Christ"?

9. Based on what you have learned from this message, how well are you doing at putting on the Armor of God? Do you struggle with utilizing any of the pieces of armor? Explain.
