The Birth of the Messiah

Luke 2:1-20

THE INCARNATION

- ① TIME LOCK: 5-4 BC
- ② PLACE: Bethlehem
- ③ POLITICAL CONTEXT: Roman Taxation Census

PRINCIPLE #1: God's sovereign power can work through any situation on earth.

PRINCIPLE #2: God is in ultimate control of every detail of your life.

- ④ DIVINE CONTEXT: Arrival of the Savior (1 Cor. 1:27-29; Galatians 4:4)
- ⑤ INITIAL RESPONSE: No room for Jesus

PRINCIPLE #3: In our fallen state, the arrival of Jesus is generally not seen as good news !

PRINCIPLE #4: Make appropriate room for Jesus Christ in your life!

- ⑥ LOCAL CONTEXT: Shepherds & Angels
 - ▶ Shepherds living out in the fields
 - ▶ It was nighttime
 - ▶ One angel appears - Surrounded by glorious light
 - ▶ Announcement – The Savior/Messiah is born
 - ▶ Sign – Wrapped in clothes & placed in a feeding trough
 - ▶ Huge angelic company appears - Praising God
 - ▶ Shepherds find Jesus, praise God & spread the word
 - ▶ People who heard the news were amazed
 - ▶ Mary treasured this memory & often thought about it
 - ▶ Luke 2:14 - *Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to men on whom His favor rests.*

❖ Try to look at Christmas from God's perspective (Luke 2:14)

❖ Regularly cast your fears & anxieties upon God's shoulders (1 Peter 5:7; John 14:27)

DISCOVER

Prepare to celebrate Jesus' birth

READ

Luke 1:1-20 Read the Christmas story aloud together.

PRAY

Digging Deeper
