LOSING THE SAVIOR (Luke 2:41-46a)

• THE Trip

PRINCIPLE #1: True faith will always <u>cost</u> you <u>comething</u>.

O THE Time

► <u>Passover</u> feast ► <u>Bar</u> <u>Mitzvah</u> preparation

PRINCIPLE #2: There is a <u>time</u> in life when God expects every human being to <u>act</u> <u>responsibly</u> before Him.

• THE <u>Misstake</u> (v.43)

QUESTION: How long does it take you to <u>notice</u> when <u>Uesus</u> is <u>missing</u> from your life?

THE Panicked Search (Luke 2:46a)

► Day #1: <u>Group</u> travel to a <u>prearranged</u> destination

► Day #2: <u>Frantic</u> travel (<u>alone</u>) back to <u>Uerusalem</u>

► Day #3: Eventually <u>find</u> <u>Jecus</u> in the <u>Temple</u> area

Where THEY FIND HIM (Luke 2:46-48) PRINCIPLE #3: No one will ever speak to you more powerful, life - jiving words than Jesus.
