THE INTERRUPTION (Luke 4:33-34)

[SIDEBAR ON DEMONIC ACTIVITY]

- Angels, good & evil, really exist
- Evil angels = fallen angels / evil spirits / unclean spirits / demons
- ▶ Before the creation of the world (and mankind), God created a fixed number of angelic beings (Mark 12:25; Luke 20:36)
- One of God's guardian angels (Lucifer) rebelled (Isaiah 14:12-15; Ezekiel 28:11-17)
- Lucifer (Satan) led 1/3 of the angels to rebel with him against God (Job 4:18; Revelation 12:4)
- Satan & his angels were defeated & cast out of heaven to earth (Revelation 12:7-10,12)
- Satan led the first human beings astray through lies, deception & seductive temptations (Genesis 3:1-7)
- ▶ When Adam & Eve sinned against God, they fell from their state of innocence (Genesis 3:7-9)
- They were separated from God & cast out of the Garden of Eden (Genesis 3:22-24)

- ► The entire earth & human race fell under the effects of the curse (Romans 5:12;
- Jesus came to destroy the devil's work & take back mankind's dominion over the earth (1 John 3:8)
- Satan & all demonic forces were defeated by Christ at the cross (Colossians 2:15)
- Satan & all demonic forces are already doomed & will be cast into the Lake of Fire (Matthew 25:41; Rev. 20:10)
- There are times when God still permits evil spirits to invade humanity

 We are commanded to submit to God & resist all demonic activity (Ephesians 6:10-18; James 4:7)
- Only in Christ can human beings have victory over demonic forces (Revelation 12:11)
- 1 The demon knew Jesus' true identity
- 2 The demon was terrified of Jesus
- 3 The demon was looking for __mercy__ (cf. Luke 8:31; 2 Peter 2:4; Jude 6)

- 4. Did you notice the double reference to authority? What is authority, and what in Jesus' message (or presentation) conveyed to those listening that He had authority?
- 5. Verse 33 states that a demon-possessed person was in the synagogue. Does this surprise you? Explain. Do you think a demon-possessed person could show up in church? If so, what might the person do, and how could the church respond if the person started disrupting?
- 6. Verses 33-34 state that the demon-possessed person cried out at the top of his voice and said several things to Jesus. What do each of the following statements spoken by the demon to Jesus insinuate about the spiritual conflict between heaven and hell and the fate of the devil and his demons?

"Ha! What do you want with us, Jesus of Nazareth?"

"Have you come to destroy us?"

"I know who You are – the Holy One of God."
