 - Morning Casting out a demon
 - At Noon Rebuking a high fever
 - At Sunset Healing all kinds of sickness & casting out demons
 - At Dawn the Next Day Refocusing & moving on with the Good News

AT NOON (Luke 4:38-39)

- (Simon) Peter lived in <u>Capernaum</u>
- Peter was <u>married</u> (cf. 1 Corinthians 9:5)
- Peter's <u>mother</u> <u>in</u> <u>law</u> was staying with them at the time
- ► Setting: <u>Lunchtime</u>
- ▶ Problem: <u>High</u> <u>fever</u>

AT SUNSET (Luke 4:40-41)

PRINCIPLE #4: The Christian life is one of <u>Gelf</u> <u>Garrifice</u>. (Mark 6:34; 2 Corinthians 12:15)

DEALING WITH THE "INVISIBLE ELEPHANT" ABOUT HEALING

- Jesus <u>sympathizes</u> with all <u>suffering</u> <u>people</u> (Hebrews 4:14-16)
- O Jesus is able to hear immediately & completely
- Ochrist's healing ministry was proof that the Kingdom of God was breaking in. (Luke 4:42-44)
- It is not always <u>God's</u> will to <u>heal</u> us.
- **6** <u>Trust</u> that God <u>knows</u> what He is doing when you <u>hurt</u>.

BORAD THE JESUS STORY FACING HUMAN SICKNESS - Luke 4:38-44

PRAYER

Begin your time together by praising God that Jesus has authority over human sickness and that we can ask Him for help.

MY STORY

1. When you need a break from the busyness of life, where do you go and what do you do? What is your favorite vacation spot where you can actually rest, relax, and recoup?

DIGGING DEEPER

- 2. What new insights did you gain from Sunday's message regarding Jesus' healing ministry?
- 3. Read Luke 4:38,39, Matthew 8:14,15 and Mark 1:29-31. What in your opinion are some possible reasons why the healing of Peter's mother-in-law is recorded in three of the gospels?
- 4. How do you think it made Peter and the other disciples feel when Jesus listened to their request for help regarding Peter's mother-inlaw? Describe a time you used prayer as a last resort to help with a challenge in your life when you could have prayed first? What reminder does **Matthew 7:7-12** give?
- 5. Often in the physical world it takes time to get over a fever. How long did it take for Simon's mother-in-law to recover after Jesus rebuked the fever? What does this indicate regarding the extent of Jesus' authority and power over sickness?

6. What did Peter's mother-in-law do immediately after she was healed? How has God's goodness to you spurred you on to greater service? How is the service of Peter's mother-in-law an example for us today?

7. How did Jesus heal people in the following passages? Do any of the healings stand out to you as particularly amazing, and how does each one show Jesus' authority over the physical world? Luke 4:40

Luke 5:18-25

- 8. What would you say to the person who said that they had difficulty believing in a God who let their child die of cancer and had not answered their many prayers for help? If something similar happened to you, would you stop praying or lose faith?
- 9. Read **Luke 4:42-44**. Jesus regularly pulled aside to pray to His Father. Why do you think it was so important for Him to do this in the midst of such a demanding lifestyle?

- 10. Based on this lesson, what could you do the next time you get sick?
- 11. If you are healthy, how are you serving God to show Him your gratitude?
