- ► ACCUSATION: Sabbath \_\_\_\_ Desecration\_
- ► RESPONSE:
  - 1 OT story (1 Samuel 21:1-6 Hungry David)
  - 2 Bold \_\_\_\_\_ (The Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath)

### STORY #2: RESCUING THE NEEDY (Luke 6:6-11)

- ► NEED: Human \_\_\_misery\_
- ► ACCUSATION: Healing = Sabbath Desecration
- ► RESPONSE:
- Expose Hypocrish
- Mercifully Heal

LESSON: Good \_\_\_\_ Dmitted \_\_ = Evil \_\_\_ Committed

### THREE APPLICATIONS POINTS

- 1 You need to know your Bible
- 2 You need a <u>weekly</u> day of <u>rest</u> (Colossians 2:16,17)
- Only in Christ do you find your <u>true</u> <u>Sabbath</u> <u>rest</u> (Matthew 11:28-30)

Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light. (Matthew 11:28-30)
