- 1. What insight, point or principle from Sunday's message really caught your attention? Why?
- 2. **Read Luke 8:16-17**. What is the purpose of the light talked about in these verses?
- 3. What is the connection between sowing into good soil in Luke 8:15 and letting one's light shine in Luke 8:16? Check all that apply.
 - ___ If we truly hear what God is saying we will sow His truth into people's lives.
 - ___ If we truly hear what God is saying we will shine our lights for all to see.

- What is one of the powerful properties of light mentioned in Luke 8:17? How does this apply to the one who shines his/her light, as well as the ones who see the light and have it shined on them? (Hint: John 3:18-21 might help here!)

- 5. **Read Luke 8:18.** This verse tells us to carefully consider how we listen to Jesus' words, because there are profound consequences for those who either receive the light and shine it, or for those who reject it. What are some of these consequences?
- 6. What are some of the reasons why Christians in the US are sometimes reluctant to shine our lights? Put another way, what are the things in our lives that tend to keep our lights from shining brightly?
- 7. **Read Luke 8:19-21.** In these verses Jesus shares, "My mother and brothers are those who hear God's word and put it into practice." Check the statements below that express what Jesus was really saying about his family:
 - ____ He obviously didn't like His family and finally had the opportunity to publically let them know.
 - ____ Jesus loved His family but wanted people to know the importance of choosing God first.
 - ____ Those who hear God's Word and do it have a close bond as members of God's family.
